What I will do is tell you the truth, bear your burdens, and love you unconditionally. From the pulpit, I will encourage you to grow in the faith, commend your faithfulness, and step on your toes – in short, I will preach the Word (II Timothy 4:2). I will do my very best to teach and preach what you need to hear, not necessarily what you want to hear. And I will never teach or preach anything that will endanger your or anyone else's soul.


What do I expect from you? Love us, help us, and encourage us. And above all, love the LORD your God will all your heart, soul, mind, and strength (Mark 12:29-30).


Together, let us spend many years working in the Lord's vineyard, and with His help, make the Puyallup church the very best it can be to the glory of God the Father. May God bless us all through His Son and our Savior Jesus Christ.
