Here's a different twist to those New Year's resolutions we all make, but so often fail to keep. In 2021, maybe we would do well to "give up" a few things rather than "add" a few things.

What to Give Up

· Give up grumbling. Instead, "In everything give thanks." (II Thessalonians 2:13)

- Give up 10-15 minutes in bed. Instead, use that time in prayer. (I Thessalonians 5:17)
- Give up looking at other people's worst points. Instead concentrate on their best ones. (Philippians 4:8)
- Give up speaking unkindly. Instead, let your speech be generous and understanding. (Colossians 4:6)
- Give up your worries. Instead, trust God with them. (Matthew 6:25-34)
- Give up hatred or dislike for others. Instead, learn to love. (I Corinthians 13)
