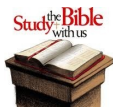

Comparisons

"For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps..." I Peter 2:21

Comparisons are so easy to make. We, like the self-righteous Pharisee often judge our righteousness by the wrong standard—each other (Luke 18:9-14). I give more money than he does—wrong comparison. I work harder and volunteer for more things than she does—wrong comparison. I've been a Christian longer than they have—wrong comparison. I've studied with and baptized more people than he has—wrong comparison.

- **"But we are all like an unclean thing, and all our righteousness are like filthy rags."** (Isaiah 64:6).
- **"There is none righteous, no not one."** (Romans 3:10).
- **"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."** (Romans 3:23).

When we compare ourselves to the only true standard, Jesus Christ, we crumble next to His perfection. And He is our only source of righteousness (Romans 3:24-26; John 14:6).


Isaiah was confronted with his righteousness as


compared to God's holiness in Isaiah 6. His response? **"Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts."** (v.5).


Have you made an honest comparison of yourself? Have you looked into the mirror of God's Word and made a truthful assessment of your condition?
