Advancing Discipleship

“Even so, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Therefore by their fruits you will know them.”

– Matthew 7:17-20

Today, we continue our studies on discipleship. We need to remember that disciples are different from those who simply hear the word of Jesus and have some understanding of it. They need more than concepts to understand – they need actions to live out. Remaining in the past or resting on previous fruit does not advance the cause of our Savior.


When they begin to live a disciple's life, their thoughts, behaviors, attitudes, and actions reflect the one whom they follow. This is the fruit they bear and


by which they are known. Jesus advances this idea in the above text (Matthew 7:17-20). He then says, "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven" (7:21).
