## Be the Tree – A Call to Conviction

*"Now the LORD had said to Abram: 'Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you'... So Abram departed as the LORD had spoken to him, and Lot went with him. And Abram was seventy-five years old when he departed from Haran." – Genesis 12:1, 4*
