

Restoring Passion in Your Relationship to Christ (pt. 1)

The following article was adapted from Kenneth Boa's book, *Conformed to His Image*, by Timothy Gunnells.

In Kenneth Boa's book, *Conformed to His Image*, he presents some thoughts regarding our relationship with Christ. His encouragement can help us cultivate or restore a passionate relationship:

1. **Growing awareness of God as a person.** God is personal and relational, but we often treat him simply as a power or principle. We should ask Him to increase our passion for Him and for Jesus.

2. **Sitting at Jesus' feet.** Giving attention to reading the Bible, meditating on it, as well as prayer and contemplation are ways we place ourselves at His feet and enjoy being with Him.

3. **Imitating the Master.** Identifying with Jesus in His death, burial, and resurrection, and ascension (Romans 6) makes it possible for us to imitate Him and follow in His steps (1 Peter 2:21). If we love Him, we will want to be more like Him.

4. **Cultivating spiritual affections.** No matter what our natural temperaments may be, it is crucial for us to develop true affections (desire, longing, zeal, craving, hunger) for God. Our desire for God should rise above all other desires.

5. **Increasing appreciation for the goodness of God.** The distraction of the world often prevent us from developing a growing appreciation for our relationship with God. We should pray for God to help us to be more grateful and amazed by His "kindness toward us in Christ Jesus" (Ephesians 2:7).

6. **Focused intention.** God is please when we pursue Him with a heart that is intent on knowing and loving Him. As our wills become more focused on becoming more like Jesus, our love for God will grow.
