Blessed Are The Peacemakers

To a faithful church in Thessalonica, Paul wrote, "**Be at peace among yourselves.**" (1 Thessalonians 5:13). This is not a suggestion—it's a command. The Greek grammar also suggests that this is present and continuing action. "Be at peace and continue being at peace among yourselves."

Anyone can be divisive—it takes no courage, no thought. Anyone can be self-willed and determined to have their own way—it takes no godliness, no selflessness. Jesus said, "**Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.**" (Matthew 5:9). Being a peacemaker takes courageousness, thoughtfulness, godliness, and selflessness. It takes effort.

God hate division among His people. "**These six things the LORD hates, yes seven are an abomination to Him: a proud look, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked plans, feet that are swiftly in running to evil, a false witness who speaks lies, and one who sows discord among brethren.**" (Proverbs 6:16-19). Paul



tells us that hatred, contentions, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, and dissensions, are all works of the flesh, stand in opposition to the fruit of the Spirit, and if left unchanged, will condemn a person's soul to hell. (Galatians 5: 19-21).

The church is in desperate need of peacemakers. There is too much gossip, backbiting, and bickering. Peter writes, "...love the brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous; not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing." (1 Peter 3:8-9). Again, Paul writes, "If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men." (Romans 12:18). How true this is in the church!

By the way, if at some time while you read this you thought it was intended for someone else, you're wrong.
