## Restoring Passion in Your Relationship to Christ (pt. 2)

The following article was adapted from Kenneth Boa's book, *Conformed to His Image*, by Timothy Gunnells. The first six points were last week - here are the final four points to his article.

In Kenneth Boa's book, *Conformed to His Image*, he presents some thoughts regarding our relationship with Christ. His encouragement can help us cultivate or restore a passionate relationship:

**7. Willingness to let God break our outward self.**  
When we cling to our false selves (the facades, worldly aspirations, and self-centered thoughts), then we cannot grow into what God would have us to become. When we are willing to give up ourselves

and allow God to mold us, then we will begin to know true life (John 12:24-25).

**8. Desiring to please God more than impress people.** Our goal should be to please the Father, just like Jesus (John 8:29). The enemy of this goal is the competing quest for the approval of human beings (John 5:41, 44; 12:43). We cannot have it both ways. In the end, only God's opinion matters.

**9. Treasuring God.** "We love, because He first loved us" (1 John 4:19). The more we realize how much God loved and valued us, the greater our capacity will be to love and value Him.

**10. Maturing in trust.** It is easier to trust God for our eternity than to trust Him daily. As long as we pursue our own desires, and approach life with our own agendas, then our confidence will be misplaced. We need to learn to trust Him and not our own performance.

It is my prayer that you will contemplate these sources of spiritual passion. Pray for God's help in cultivating them, and cast aside the things that detract you for a deep relation with Him.
