For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body – whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free – and have all been made to drink into one Spirit. For in fact the body is not one member but many."- I Corinthians 12:12-14

members of the body of Christ have different talents and abilities. No members are unimportant - all are not only needed, but are necessary for the body to function properly.


We have become one body through Christ. That which binds us is stronger than that which divides us. Come, let us learn and grow together.


