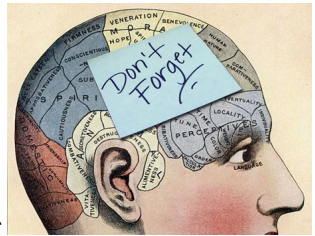

MEMORY!

Think for a moment regarding all the things the mind absorbs during a lifetime. Like a large four-drawer file cabinet filled with years of collected material, sometimes there is a struggle to retrieve some of the bits of information. Though there are times words and incidents jog the memory, there are also times when memory simply needs to be worked at.



It has been said, "A well-trained memory is one that permits you to forget everything that isn't worth remembering." [Battista] This reminds me of a member of our congregation who used to say, "My forgetory is working too well." Struggling with what we need to **remember** and what we wish or ought to **forget** is a part of life. However, as we struggle with our own **remembering and forgetting**, let us never lose sight of what marks that of our gracious God.

Regarding **God's remembering** the writer of Hebrews encouraged. . . "(10) **For God is not unjust so as to overlook your work and the love that you have shown for his name in serving the saints, as you still do.**" (Hebrews 6:10 ESV).

The Greek word translated "overlook" is "epilanthonomai" and means "to forget" or

“forgotten.” [Strong’s Lexicon] God remains fully aware of what good we are doing for others and for Him in life. The things others either don’t see or fail to keep in mind, **God remembers** and rewards!

Regarding the great mind of **God’s forgetting**, the writer of Hebrews (quoting from the prophet Jeremiah) stated. . . **“(12) For I will be merciful toward their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more.”** (Hebrews 8:12 ESV).

When God forgives, He forgets. Though we might struggle with putting past sins from our mind, God has fully forgiven as if they never happened. He no longer holds those things against us.

Praise God for His great mind with regard to both **His remembrance and His forgetfulness** on our behalf. May we also learn to extend such graciousness toward others as well.
