

#### **Two Yokes**

Jesus knows that people are weary and heavyladen, struggling, and burdened, laboring and weighted down, tired, exhausted and falling under the load. What's the burden? Sin and everything that is here because of it—disease, death, doubt, disappointment, and disillusionment. He knows that rest is what we need, and He offers it. What a welcome invitation!

But what is a yoke doing in the middle of an invitation to rest? For the agriculturally challenged, a yoke is a framework that pairs two beasts of burden. It fits around their necks, and a plow or some other tool is attached to it. A yoke is usually a metaphor for submission and bondage; it doesn't typically suggest rest.

The truth is, we are locked in a yoke before we come to Jesus. Jeremiah wept on behalf of his people: "My transgressions were bound into a yoke; by His hand they were fastened together; they were set upon my neck; He caused my strength to fail" (Lamentations 1:14 ESV). Everyone is either a slave to sin which leads to death or a slave to obedience which leads to righteousness (Romans 6:16). When we are yoked to sin, the yoke is iron, and sin does not pull its share of the load. Trudging through life without Christ is the worst of burdens.

As we keep working toward the end of life's row, the choice is not whether to be yoked but which yoke to wear. We can stay yoked to sin and its dead weight, or we can be joined to Jesus. His yoke is easy, and his burden is light. He's a workhorse!

Drawing on His power for the work, and enjoying His gentle and humble company until the work is finished—I can rest in that yoke.
