

God's Grace Teaches Us

The lessons that impact us the most are often those that are taught through action rather than word. Francis of Assisi once said "Preach the Gospel at all times. Use words if necessary." While using words is essential, our actions must be consistent with our teaching if it is to make an impact.

God's word teaches us to live differently than the world around us, but God did not rely on just using words to teach us how to live. God teaches us in a much more powerful way – through the example of Jesus. "For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people. It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live selfcontrolled, upright and godly lives in this present age" (Titus 2:11-12, NIV). Grace appeared in the person of Jesus who sets an example of what it means to be godly and motivates us through offering Himself to pay for our sinfulness. God offers us His grace, His unmerited favor, through what Jesus has done. There is no greater motivation to live for Him than what He has done for us.

God has been consistently good and gracious to us. When we stop to consider His work in our lives, we can't help but become more thankful, joy-filled people who are motivated to live for Him. I encourage you to take some time and think through the ways God has shown His grace to you.
