



#### What is Faith?

Benjamin Franklin is credited with stating that "in this world nothing can be said to be certain, except death and taxes." We are repeatedly confronted with the reality of uncertainty as we see what goes on in the world around us. This troubles many who desire stability and a level of certainty. This could be why the psychic industry has grown to over 2 billion dollars recently – people are uncomfortable with uncertainty and do not know where to turn.

As Christians we can take comfort in what God's word offers because it tells us we can have confidence in the Lord. "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen" (Heb. 11:1 NASB). Another version says that

faith is the "evidence" of what is not seen. Faith is confidence because we can look at the evidence of what God has already done in creation and throughout history in keeping His word to His people perfectly. His promises have never failed (just ask Joshua – Josh. 21:43-45).

While the world may not know where to turn for stability and certainty in this life, we know that we can take comfort by faith in our God. Our faith gives us assurance of what we do not see - that our future is secure in Christ. This is the message that a lost and uncertain world needs to hear and see lived out in us.
