We shall reap such joys in the by and by, But what have we sown today? We shall build mansions up in the sky, But what have we built today?


Oh, how sweet it is in fond dreams to bask, But right here and now we must do our task. Yes, this is the thing that our souls must ask, Just what have we done today?

Friday Night Singing: The Friday night singings will be at the building while the preteens and teens study and practice for the


