Ty thought for a moment and then asked her for some clarification. "You are a racist?" the kids around the table laughed and the teacher quickly cleared up the confusion, "No races, ra-cessss."

It is easy to miss the beginning of a conversation. Maybe you are not paying attention to the person and they just start talking. There could be any number of reasons you may miss the beginning of a conversation. The one consistent thing is that if you do miss the start of a discussion you are most likely lost immediately.

teaching and writing (Matt. 19:3-9; Mk. 10:6-10; 2 Corinthians 11:3; 1 Peter 3:20, 21).

Some may think that the Old Testament is passé, or not for us today but that could not be further from the truth. Genesis holds important truths that will never go out of style. Truths that will stand the test of time. Truths that we need to still hear today.

If you miss the beginning of the conversation, you have missed a lot.

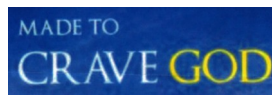
