Me... or Him?

We live in a "me, myself, and I" saturated culture. Advertisers entice us with such slogans as, "Have it Your Way," "Get Your own Bag," "No rules, Just Right," and "Obey Your Thirst." These types of sayings appeal to a society more and more self-centered. All facets of life are affected by this mentality, and unfortunately, the Lord's church has found this mindset worthy of consideration.

Some have determined for themselves how and upon what terms their relationship with God will be established. He has given us the freedom to choose between the wide gate and the narrow gate (Matthew 7:13-14), but he never gave us the right to dictate the terms of our salvation (Luke 9:23-26).

Many are now making worship and Christian life to be about them and not God. We hear such things as, "God wouldn't want me to be unhappy," "My spiritual needs aren't being met," "I want to be a part of a church that does

_____,” and “I don’t feel like the church is relevant.” Please take notice of the subject of each of these statements - it’s about me, not Him.


Consider for a moment the sixty-six books of the Bible - Where do we find the authority to focus on ourselves in order to be pleasing and acceptable to God? To whom are we to direct our religious homage and devotion (worship)? To ourselves or God? (Matthew 4:10; John 4:21-24). To whom are we to serve and consider above ourselves? Is it not God and others? (Matthew 22:37-40).


The Bible clearly teaches the concept of the church [repentant, baptized believers (Acts 2:38, 41, 47)] being the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:12-27; Romans 12:4-5) with Christ Himself as its Head (Ephesians 1:22-23; Colossians 1:18). In a healthy, normal body, the head determines how the rest of the body functions. Are we going to dictate to the Head what or how we will function?


Come, let us learn and grow together.
