Grace Motivates

Many of us struggle to be motivated from time to time. This can be the result of a number of things, but it is a problem that we probably all have faced to some extent or another.

Lack of motivation can affect us in both the physical and spiritual. Sometimes it is difficult to find the motivation to do a good deed when the opportunity arises. It can be even harder to find the motivation to forgive while still feeling hurt. This is where the grace of God comes in. When we focus on our own hardship in helping others or our own pain when forgiveness is needed, the task can seem impossible. When we consider God's grace, it becomes much less of a burden. Because we have been saved by grace, we can find motivation to do

the good works that God has prepared for us to do (Eph. 2:8-10). Forgiving someone who hurt us can seem impossible until we consider the forgiveness we have received from God. "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you" (Eph. 4:32, NIV).

God not only teaches us through His grace to do what is right, He gives us motivation to do it when we really consider how good He has been to us. When doing good to someone else or forgiving a hurt feels like too much, let's consider the grace that God has shown us.
