## Opportunities at Delano Bay

Delano Bay Christian Camp has been providing a place for Christian renewal, recharge and advance since 1979, mostly in the form of summer camps for teen age children. Many churches, families and groups have been encouraged and edified



throughout the years as well. Several changes have occurred and more are needed. Most notably the original seaside cabins are in need of extensive repairs and upgrades. These are original cabins, built in the 1920's and still used by families, small groups as well as overflow for summer camps. Different congregations are each adopting a cabin and planning on making the needed improvements. We are partnering with Kibler church of Christ to renovate Bamboo. They will be sharing in the costs and work with us.

The immediate need is for replacing a broken window and then replacing the shower. Joel Ravet is working to get a new window installed before a group uses the cabin in mid-March. A group of Sojourners will be here in May to install the shower and money has already been donated towards its purchase.

Ultimately we would like to see the entire interior redone with upgraded electrical, plumbing, insulation, all new energy efficient window, sheet rocking, appliances and curtains. The exterior may need some repairs and painting as well. Over

the course of the next year or so, we can use help with plans, securing materials and supplies, conducting the work. Your hands, your donations and your prayers will help us accomplish this work so the camp can continue to provide a great place of refuge and renewal for Christians of all ages.

Closer to home, we could use one or more people to set up and maintain a bulletin board about the camp. People with skill and gifts in crafts and artistry, here is a place for you! Come share your abilities to help us all be better informed about the camp.

Beyond this work, there are opportunities to help serve at summer camps. Robert Henton will be co-directing the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade camps along with Ben Cook. They can use help with kitchen help and camp counselors. Other summer camps may also need help. See Gene McCaul if you are interested in these opportunities.

There is a work day coming up April 11<sup>th</sup>. Come out and see Bamboo, clean up from the winter weather and help get the camp ready for summer camps. All skill levels are welcome. See the bulletin board (when it is ready!) for more information.

The first weekend in June is Delano Day and provides an opportunity to serve and see the camp. Several of our members have assembled baskets for a silent auction, a fun and helpful event. Talk with Jim and Debbie Johnson if you need basket ideas or want to help. Otherwise make plans to come enjoy a day of fun at the camp and visit Bamboo.
