Faith Means Walking With God

One of people's greatest fears is death. We go to extraordinary lengths to keep ourselves on this earth just a little bit longer in spite of all the problems this world has. One of the greatest things about our faith is that it leads to life in Christ.


Hebrews 11:5 tells us that "By faith Enoch was taken from this life, so that he did not experience death...For before he was taken, he was commended as one who pleased God." (NIV). Because of his faith Enoch did not have to face death. While we know that we will all have to die physically (Heb. 9:27), because of our faith in God we do not have to be afraid of death.


John speaks about this life of faith as "walking in


the light" (1 Jn. 1:7). Just as Enoch pleased God in the way he walked, we can please God in the same way. Although we cannot escape death in this life as Enoch did, we can be assured of eternal life after death because of what Jesus has done for us (1 Jn. 5:13). In Christ we do not have to fear as the world fears. In Christ we can have confidence and comfort even in death, for in death we will be raised to walk with God.
