## Thinking of Others

*"For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly..."*

Romans 12:3

Back in 1971, Gale Sayers, one of the greatest running backs in the history of the National Football League (NFL), wrote an autobiography titled, ***I Am Third***. The premise of the book was God is first, my family is second, and I am third.

In much the same way, yet to a greater extent, Paul teaches us likewise in his discussion of the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23). He deals with our attitude toward God in the first three (love, joy, and peace) and ourselves in the last three (faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control). In the middle three, he turns his (and our) attention to our attitude toward others (longsuffering, kindness, and goodness).

Thinking of others before ourselves is a basic teaching of our Savior Jesus Christ. He taught us that the second greatest commandment was to love your neighbor as yourself (Luke 10:27b). He even explained who our neighbor is and how we are to love in the parable of the good Samaritan (vv. 30-35).

The servant (we as Christians) is not greater than

his/her master (the Lord Jesus Christ) - so teaches Jesus Himself in John 15:20. And how did Jesus treat others, including His enemies? **“By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us.”** (I John 3:16a). The second part of this verse is also quite telling: **“And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.”**

*“Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God...Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.”*
