God is in Control of My Situation


Has life ever seemed hopeless? Sometimes things happen that lead us to believe there is no way out or no solution to the problems that we face.

Daniel would have had every excuse to feel that way and give up on life. He was carried off to Babylon in 606 BC as a captive of Nebuchadnezzar's army. Daniel, along with Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego faced uncertainty and likely discouragement at times in ways that we cannot fully understand. Even in such a difficult circumstance the Bible tells us that "Daniel made up his mind" that he was going to do right according to God's law (Dan. 1:8). As a result of their faithfulness, God caused them to prosper and to be better to the king than all of his other wise men.


Today we may worry about what is going on in our nation politically, economically, and morally, or we may worry about what is happening to us personally in some situations. Jesus assures His people that when we put our trust in God and seek Him first that everything we need will be taken care of. Our situation may seem hopeless at times, but God is still in control and He has promised to take care of those who seek Him (Matt. 6:33).
