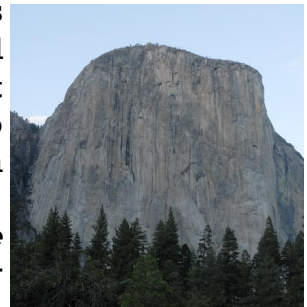
### Psalm 27:1

***“The LORD is my light and my salvation;  
Whom shall I fear?  
The LORD is the strength of my life;  
Of whom shall I be afraid?”***

This psalm of David shows his trust and faith in God. David understood hardships of the most extreme kind, and he also understood Who was there when he was in the deepest need.

David's confidence was in **the LORD**, who will not leave us nor forsake us (Deuteronomy 31:6, 8; Joshua 1:5; Hebrews 13:5). He was his **light** in a sin-darkened world (Psalm 119:105; I John 1:5; 2:8). He was his **salvation** from physical and spiritual foes (Psalm 3:8; Acts 4:12). He was his **strength** in a body of weakness and failure (Psalm 28:7; Romans 5:6).

The Lord's light, salvation, and strength provides a buffer and an antidote for **fear** (being afraid). Those who seek our harm are numerous and powerful (by the world's standards). Satan continues to prowl as a roaring lion seeking whom he may devour (I Peter
