The One We Long For

Imagine that you are talking with a stranger at the local convenient store while pumping your gas, and they suddenly revealed your most intimate and shameful secret. You're stunned, not because they brought it up, but because they know about it. Yet, they don't shame you or make you feel judged, but spend time with you, loving you and showing grace. This person has intimate knowledge of your most shameful acts, and yet has shown you more mercy than your closest friends. It changes you. Suddenly, you realize that what you were really longing for, the deep ache of your soul that you filled with a line of broken relationships, suddenly finds satisfaction in this chance interaction with a stranger (who suddenly feels like so much more).

I'm not sure, but I imagine that's how a Samaritan woman felt when she met a strange man named Jesus at a Well in Sychar. A conversation over a drink of water suddenly


turned into the most important moment in this woman's life. A chance encounter turned into a moment of deep mercy.


Practically, we could discuss the benefits of really listening to people, taking moments to reach people with understanding, love, and grace. Or, we can simply see ourselves, broken by the waves of life, dull and plodding towards the well for a simple drink of water, and yet suddenly finding our bellies full of living streams because we see the One our heart has been longing for.


Either way, if we read John 4 with open hearts, we will find ourselves "worshipping in truth and spirit" (John 4:24) before we end the chapter.
