Back in 1981 I wanted to be Indiana Jones. He was cool, his hat was cool, and his whip was cool. Indy got to dig up all sorts of interesting things and he did it in that swashbuckling sort of way. You know, the same way I do my preaching.



There have been some very fascinating things people have dug up in real life too, for example...

Evidence for ancient chemical warfare:¹ Romans and the Persians were slugging it out many years ago and the Romans look like they got the raw end of the deal. Well at least 20 of them perhaps. Archaeologists say the Persians left a petrochemical trap for the Romans. Nasty.

Or a leper warrior:² Usually separate and apart from the rest of polite society, there seems to be an Italian soldier who had leprosy and fought and died along men not infected with the disease.

And then someone dug up this. A 1,800-year-old stone carving of what may be the head of a Roman god was recently found in an ancient garbage dump.³

Someone just threw their god away. Why would they do that? Maybe he did not do what they wanted, who knows, but we do have one thing in common with whoever had their local garbage man carry out their idol.

Our God was buried too...

But unlike the idol dumped in the garbage our Lord was not dug up by someone, He rose from the grave. Peter told people who were wondering about that very question, "Fellow Israelites, I can tell you confidently that the patriarch David died and was buried, and his tomb is here to this day; Seeing what was to come, he spoke of the resurrection of the Messiah, that he was not abandoned to the realm of the dead, nor did his body see decay. God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of it. Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear" (Acts 2:29, 31-33).
