

## <u>All Will Acknowledge That God is in</u> <u>Control</u>

We like to think of ourselves as being in control of our own lives. Especially in this country, we like to think that we can do anything we set our minds to with no limit, and the idea of submitting to the control of someone else is not one we like to hear.

King Nebuchadnezzar was the most powerful man in the world at the time of the Babylonian Empire. He had conquered other nations and subjected their people to whatever he desired. He thought he had done all of this on his own but was quickly corrected. "Is not this the great Babylon I have built as the royal residence, by my mighty power and for the glory of my majesty?" (Dan. 4:30 NIV) Nebuchadnezzar did not realize that his power and authority really came from God. As a result, God had Nebuchadnezzar driven away from people to live as a wild animal. This would be his situation until he acknowledged "that the Most High is sovereign over all kingdoms on earth and gives them to anyone he wishes." (Dan. 4:32 NIV) Even the mightiest king on earth was forced to submit to God.

While it appears that less people want to acknowledge God today, choosing rather to boast in their own accomplishments, power, and intellect, one day everyone will acknowledge the One who rules over all. One day everyone will bow before and confess the lordship of Jesus Christ (Phil. 2:9-11). God is still in control today, and it is in our best interest to acknowledge and submit to His ways.
