Faith Overcomes Obstacles

Obstacles are a part of life regardless of who we are or what we do. Whether it is financial, social, family, or work related, all of us could probably name some obstacle that we currently face. The real question is how we view the obstacles – do we look to ourselves or do we, by faith, look to God?

"By faith the people passed through the Red Sea as on dry land; but when the Egyptians tried to do so, they were drowned. By faith the walls of Jericho fell, after the army had marched around them for seven days." (Heb. 11:29-30, NIV). When the Israelites were led out of Egypt, God led them right into what appeared to be a trap at the Red Sea. He had a great plan but, marching into a parted sea with walls of

water on each side required trusting God and obeying Him. When Joshua led Israel into the Promised Land 40 years later, they faced what appeared to be an insurmountable obstacle – Jericho. In each case, the Israelites trusted God enough to look at the obstacle in light of His ability rather than their own.

What obstacle are you currently facing? Have you brought it to the Lord in prayer to seek a solution? God wants to hear from us about our needs, and He stands ready to answer when you approach Him. The God who parted the Sea and knocked down Jericho's walls stands ready to answer when you speak to Him about your obstacles. Is your focus on the obstacles or is your focus on the God who overcomes?
