Trusting God

Sometimes in our lives, events or circumstances present themselves in such a way as to challenge our beliefs or practices. It may be a job change, sickness, financial hardship, death, relationship difficulties, or even the poor actions of fellow Christians. Stop and ask yourself...in difficult times, where is your trust?

Several faithful Old Testament individuals experienced extreme, life-altering circumstances. Job lost every physical blessing except for his life. Amid all the confusion and poor advice of his so-called friends, he was still able to say, "**Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him.**" (13:5). Whatever loss you have experienced, as important as it is, very likely does not reach the extreme circumstances faced by Job. Can you, like him, make the same claim with full assurance?

David was pursued by many enemies with the intention

of taking his life. Even Saul, God's anointed, desired to end his life. Even though the 13th Psalm begins with questioning if God had forgotten him, he concludes, **"But I have trusted in Your mercy; my heart shall rejoice in Your salvation."** (13:5-6). During the foul and unfair treatment of others, which probably has not included the attempted taking of your life, can you, like David, rejoice in the bounty of God?

Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego lost their freedom and were threatened with a fiery death for refusing Nebuchadnezzar's command to worship the image. Their trust in God was so pronounced, they responded, **"Our God we serve is able to deliver us...But if not...we do not serve your gods."** (Daniel 3:17-18). We often claim to believe that God is able to deliver us (and rightly so), yet when that deliverance does not come as we might think, can we, like these three, say, **"But if not...?"**
