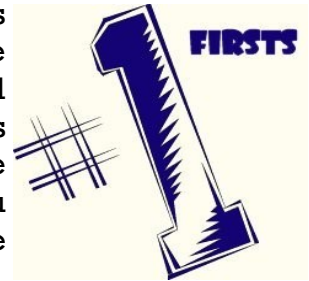

## First and Foremost (pt. 1)

The word "first" pinpoints priority; it identifies the importance of success and happiness. Remember, success is getting what you want while happiness is wanting what you get. The "first things" in life declare what's most important.



Thus, what are the most importance things to a Christian; what's first?

**1. Give God the FIRST hour of each day.** Begin each day listening to God (reading the Bible) and talking to God (praying to God through Jesus). Prayer and Bible study are irreplaceable. They are NOT mutually exclusive; they are totally and completely dependence one upon the other. Thus, meditate daily on God's Word (Ps. 1:2) and pray with priority (1 Tim. 2:1).

**2. Give God the FIRST day of each week.** Christians honor the day of Jesus' resurrection: Sunday (John 20:1). We assemble on the "first day of the week" (Acts 20:7) as did the early Church. We assemble each Sunday and remember what the Lord has done for us (1 Cor. 11:24,25); we honor, praise and glorify Him (Rev. 4:11; 5:12). The exhortation we
