## Faith Means Accepting the Truth

Change is rarely easy. Whether we change jobs, homes, diets, or just a small part of our daily routine, change is difficult. This is because change often involves pain and giving up something important.

Rahab had to make quite a bit of change in her life because she understood the power of God even if she did not know Him yet. "By faith Rahab the harlot did not perish along with those who were disobedient, after she had welcomed the spies in peace" (Heb. 11:31, NASB). She went against her own country because she recognized that the God of Israel was the true God. She said to the spies that "the Lord your God, He is God in heaven above and on earth beneath" (Josh. 2:11, NASB). As difficult as it

must have been, she chose to go against all she had ever known nationally and religiously in order to ally herself with the people of the true God. She looked at the evidence of what God had done for Israel and accepted the truth. Because of her great faith and willingness to change, she is not only recorded in Hebrews 11 as having great faith, she is also in the genealogy of Jesus (Matt. 1:5).


When we have the faith to change, God can do incredible things through us – regardless of what our past holds. As Rahab illustrates by her willingness to change, God can and will use anyone who is willing to turn to Him.
