

God is in Control and He Hears Your <u>Prayers</u>

Talking to someone in a powerful position can seem intimidating to many. Imagine getting to spend time with the president or a foreign national leader. Many may not even know what they would say in such a situation. We may not think that our words would carry any weight or that we would be really listened to.

Daniel was carried away to Babylon as a captive where God caused him to prosper. Later the Medes and Persians took over and Daniel again did well because of his faith in God. When others saw this they were jealous and tried to find a way to bring him down. Their manipulative plan involved the creation of a law that would have Daniel thrown into a den of

hungry lions because he refused to stop praying to God. As they predicted, Daniel continued to pray even after the law was signed by king Darius. Daniel continued to be faithful to God even though he knew it could cost his life. When Daniel was protected by God from the lions, the text tells us that "no injury whatever was found on him, because he had trusted in his God" (Dan. 6:23, NASB). God saw Daniel's faithfulness and listened as he prayed. God was and is in full control, so He protected His faithful servant.

As intimidating as it may sound to talk to one who rules over a state or a nation, we have access all the time to speak with one who has far more power. He listens when you call out to Him and answers when you come to Him in faith. He is in complete control, and He wants to hear from you.


