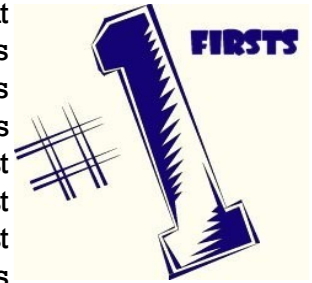

First and Foremost (pt. 2)

The word "first" pinpoints priority; it identifies the importance of success and happiness. Remember, success is getting what you want while happiness is wanting what you get. The "first things" in life declare what's most important. Thus, what are the most important things to a Christian; what's first?



- 1. Give God the FIRST hour of each day.**
- 2. Give God the FIRST day of each week.**
- 3. Give God the FIRST portion of your pay.**
- 4. Give God the FIRST consideration in every decision.**

Decisions are inevitable, thus each one must be made with care. Joshua is exemplary in personal and collective decisions. In Joshua 24:15, he first chose for himself. Personal choice is decisive and influential. His first duty was for himself, then he chose for his family. It is a powerful example when a man is able to speak for the decisions of his home. The greatest choice we can make, whether personal or domestic, is to obey Jesus.

5. Give God the FIRST place in your heart. The object of our complete love (heart, mind, soul and strength) is God (Mk. 12:30). Since God is in heaven, our affections (mind & heart) must be there centered (Col. 3:1-4). As we deposit treasures
