



Faith Faces the Impossible

We have all heard the saying that someone in a difficult situation is "between a rock and a hard place." This refers to the kind of situation where there seems to be no solution – or at least not an easy one.

This is the kind of situation Gideon likely felt he was in as he hid in the winepress to thresh the wheat (Judges 6:11). The Midianites were oppressing Israel because they had turned away from the Lord. It was in this context that the angel of the Lord approached Gideon and commanded him to go and save Israel. Gideon saw himself and his family as the least and the weakest. It was his faith rather than his strength that was important because God promised him, "I will be with you and you will strike down all the Midianites, leaving none

alive" (Judges 6:16, NIV). Because of his faith in God, Gideon went on to command most of his army to go home, trusting that God would use only 300 men to defeat Israel's oppressors.

By human strength Gideon's victory over the Midianites would have been impossible. Only by God's power were the more than 100,000 Midianites defeated (Judges 8:10). When we put our faith in God, it does not matter how big or impossible the task is because God is able to accomplish the impossible through the faithful.


