

Faith Leads to Prayer

One of the wisest men I have known once said, "I do not believe in the power of prayer, but in the power of God who answers prayer." Prayer is only effective when it is addressed to the One who has power. To pray to a false god is wholly ineffective because there is no one to answer – there is no power.

Hebrews 11:32 mentions David as a man of great faith, but it does not specify what aspect of his faithfulness the author had in mind. While there are a number of examples of David's great faith, one of the greatest is his devotion to prayer. A common phrase in the account of David's life is that "David inquired of the Lord." This can be seen when he prepared to go

into battle, and it can also be seen when David prayed in the aftermath of his own sin (2 Sam. 12). This is because David knew that the source of his power to rule was found in God alone. David's faith in God drove him to regularly speak to God.

Our prayer habits are one of several good indicators of the kind of faith we have in God. Do you look to God to direct your life or do you look somewhere else? As our faith in God grows, so will the time we spend in prayer.


