

God Keeps His Word

None of us likes being lied to or deceived. It leaves us feeling taken advantage of and devalued. Unfortunately we have gotten accustomed to certain people in our society being dishonest. We insist on lengthy contracts in business because, at some level, we expect people to find loopholes around keeping their word.

When the Jews were taken into Babylonian captivity, God promised that they would return to their land after 70 years (Jer. 29:10). The book of Daniel records that God had plans all along to bring His people back to rebuild Jerusalem (Dan. 9:25). Our daily Bible reading schedule has had us reading this very thing this past week. The book of Nehemiah records that God brought His people back to rebuild the city. He kept His promise.

History shows us that God always keeps His word. We may feel as though many in our society cannot be trusted, and we may have grown accustomed to being lied to in some situations. In contrast to this, God can be absolutely trusted. Paul tells us that our God cannot lie (Titus 1:2). God promises to forgive when we turn to Him (1 Jn. 1:9), He promises to be with us as we do His work (Matt. 28:20), and He promises that He will never leave us (Heb. 13:5).
