

#### <u>Seek True Understanding of the One in</u> <u>Control</u>

Everyone has their own ideas of how the world works. We all have opinions, and often we will fight against changing our mind. We like to bring others to our way of thinking, but we do not enjoy when our own ideas are shown to be wrong. Changing our thinking in this way takes humility, and it is not much fun.

In Daniel 10 we read about a scary vision that Daniel had. It shook him up to the point that he mourned, fasted, and prayed for three entire weeks. Daniel 10:12 tells us that during this time he set his mind on gaining understanding and humbling himself before God. Because of this, God heard and answered his prayers. Because of this kind of attitude, Daniel was referred to by heavenly messengers as a man of high esteem three times (9:23; 10:11, 19).

Our desire is to be pleasing to God, but it requires that we be willing to swallow our pride. If we are to be pleasing to God, we have to seek to truly understand His will. We have to approach His word to find the truth rather than to back up what we already think. If we are to please God, we must approach God and His word with humility (1 Pet. 5:5).
