True Worshipers

We began a sermon series last Sunday on "True Worshipers," which will go through the first Sunday in July. In conjunction with the lessons, let me also present a series of articles on preparing for worship.

Preparing for Worship - Part I

I made the comment this past Sunday that most of us (myself included) do not come into our assembly properly prepared to worship the Lord. Immediately after service, it was suggested to me that I bring some lessons on how to prepare for worship. I plan to bring those lessons in the future, but the importance of this subject demanded immediate attention.

The first, and perhaps the most important thing we must address in preparing for worship is sin. In I Corinthians 11:28, Paul instructs us to "examine" ourselves BEFORE partaking of the Lord's Supper, so that we do not partake in an unworthy manner. Can we do any less before singing praises, praying, giving, or studying God's Word?

"If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (I John 1:8-9). This was written to Christians and it applies directly to you and me. Before we come to worship our Creator, we must remove the barrier we have

erected between ourselves and God: a barrier of selfishness, jealousy, greed, lust, deceit, anger, etc.

Prepare today, and every Lord's Day, by asking God to forgive you so you may truly worship in spirit and truth.

with more information, including time and location.






to bring salads, desserts, and/or drinks.
