

## <u>God is in Control When I Feel Like I am</u> <u>Not</u>

There are lots of people in our country today who feel as if we have lost control of our culture. As we see the morality and common sense of those around us decline, it can cause anxiety as it seems like the whole nation is spiraling out of control.

It is likely that many Jews felt as if they had no control over their own situation after the Empire of Greece was divided. Daniel 11 tells us that this empire was divided into four parts after the death of Alexander the Great, and that the Jews were caught in the middle of the constant conflicts of Egypt and Syria. Control of Judea shifted back and forth between these two nations as they fought one another for multiple generations. The Jews were largely helpless in this and were subject to persecution on more than one occasion. Daniel 11 gives detailed prophecy of this entire period which shows that God was aware of all that happened and was in complete control. Even when His people were struggling, He was still on the throne.

We may feel anxious and sometimes helpless as we see what is going on around us. It is difficult to see truth being denied and even scoffed at. Even in the midst of all that is happening, God is still on His throne. He has not relinquished His sovereignty over His creation, and we can rest assured that one day He will make everything right.
