God is in Control When I Feel Like I am

There are lots of people in our country today who feel as if we have lost control of our culture. As we see the morality and common sense of those around us decline, it can cause anxiety as it seems like the whole nation is spiraling out of control.

It is likely that many Jews felt as if they had no control over their own situation after the Empire of Greece was divided. Daniel 11 tells us that this empire was divided into four parts after the death of Alexander the Great, and that the Jews were caught in the middle of the constant conflicts of Egypt and Syria.
