Holy Ground

"Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance; but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, 'Be holy, for I am holy.'" - 1 Peter 1:13-16

Moses was tending his father-in-law's sheep near Horeb one day when the Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire in the midst of a bush. As he approached, God called to him. (Exodus 3:1-4). Moses was told, ***"Take the sandals from your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground."*** (v. 5).



What was it that made that place 'holy ground?' The location? Not very likely. The correct answer is two-fold. Firstly, it was holy ground primarily because of Who (the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob - v. 6) was present. Secondly, it was because of what was taking place (God's commissioning of Moses) in that location.

There are times when we, too, stand on holy ground. Anytime we gather as His church, we assemble on holy


ground, particularly while we are partaking of the Lord's Supper. When God's word is read, we stand on holy ground, for He speaks to us today through His inspired word. When a repentant believer obeys the gospel, we stand on holy ground as we return to Calvary for the washing of the blood of Christ.

We must give extreme care to our actions and attitudes when we stand upon holy ground, and when we figuratively or literally return to the scenes where the history of mankind has been forever changed.


Come, let us learn and grow together.
