Why We Sing

Singing in worship to the Lord is primarily about our thankfulness. Consider the two most common verses in the New Testament concerning singing:

"...speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, **giving thanks always** for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ..." - Ephesians 5:19-20

"Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. And whatever you do in word or in deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, **giving thanks to God the Father** through Him." - Colossians 3:16-17

Thanksgiving is grateful acknowledgement of benefits or blessings received. The giving of thanks presupposes that the person who engages in this recognizes these three things: 1) that the blessings enjoyed were bestowed by another, so a person cannot in all honesty claim credit for them, 2) that the

person is totally unworthy of the blessings, and 3) that such blessings are great and evident.

By the singing of psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, believers express their gratitude to the God from whom all blessings flow. Whether by singing songs of praise and exaltation, songs of joy, or songs of a heart bowed down with sorrow, the reason we sing is because we are truly thankful for past and present blessings and look forward to those in the future.
