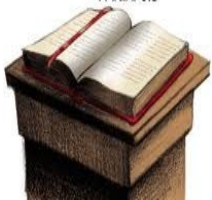

Reopening Plans, Part 3

We continue to work towards a target reopening date of June 21st. Progress is being made in several areas. For one, Pierce County has just moved to Phase 2, which relaxes many restrictions, but still has many other restrictions still in place, especially regarding church assemblies. We have been using the CDC guidelines for our planning purposes. Second, we have ordered the necessary equipment and are working towards being able to have live broadcast of our services from the building. This is something we have been discussing and working towards even before this pandemic. Third, we have ordered the needed cleaning supplies and communion supplies to be able to minimize the risk of transferring the virus on surfaces. We expect supplies and equipment to be ready by the 21st.

As was shared in last week's bulletin, we are looking at two separate services with the same sermon, songs and

communion lesson. Communion protocols at this time include having families pick up pre-packaged emblems when they enter the building. Alternatively, if families wish to bring their own supplies, that will be fine. This will eliminate the passing of trays for now and any potential for virus transfer. We will be blocking off every other row to keep families 6 feet apart and the rows that were not used in the early service would be available during the second service, with cleaning done in-between. There will be other such protocols as well. All such protocols are designed to help us worship together and stay safe and healthy. We appreciate your continued prayers and patience as we work through these times.
