### Faith as a Foundation

"To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ...for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith..." (II Peter 1:1, 5). When Jesus asked His disciples, "...who do you say that I am," Peter responded with, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:15-16).

Faith is the foundational principle of Christianity. Jesus said so following Peter's confession when He said, "...and on this rock I will build My church... (Matthew 16:18). This word rock is *petra*, which literally refers to a rock ledge or a bedrock, something which is used to build upon. Belief (faith) in Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the living God would become that upon which the church was and continues to be built.

The same is true of our individual spiritual lives. We start with faith, not end with faith. The Hebrew writer states, "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen" (11:1). The word translated "substance" actually means a setting or placing under – in other words, as substructure or foundation.

It is upon this foundation that our entire Christian lives are built. It is to this substructure that Peter encourages us to add the Christian graces of virtue, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, and love (II Peter 1:5-7).

Come, let us learn and grow together.

**Background Checks:** As part of standard operating procedures, all elders, deacons, ministers, teachers, and teaching assistants will be required to undergo background checks to help us protect ourselves and those we minister to. After you electronically sign to agree to this background check, you will need to allow at least 30 minutes to complete filling out the form. Results of all background checks are then emailed to the church, reviewed and kept on file. All reports will be kept confidential. Please see Jimmy Zakem if you have questions or concerns. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

 **Important Notice:** There have been some recent changes to the building and **IMPORTANT** congregational security procedures. The entry/exit doors on the north and south sides of the building will be locked at the beginning and unlocked at the end of Sunday morning class. They will be re-locked just prior to the start of the Sunday morning service. We apologize for any inconvenience caused in the past couple of weeks and thank you for your cooperation.

 **2017 Change-A-Life:** We will be helping with Mountain States Children's Home and their Change-A-Life Change Can campaign through **August 13, 2017** They care for 25-30 children each year who come from abuse, neglect and troubled family situations. Funds raised will help purchase clothing, school needs and perishable food items, which normally cost about **\$60,000** per year. This is a great way to help children in need.
