The Praying Christ

Prayer is as powerful as God, because He has promised to answer it. The only limits of prayer are the limits of God's will and power. Jesus believed and practiced this truth. At the tomb of Lazarus, Jesus declared His life of prayer (John 11:41-43). **The praying Christ!** The praying God! **Arresting!** Jesus was "God in Man," having the Spirit without measure (John 1:1, 14-17; 3:34), yet **He needed prayer!** He prayed more than anyone who ever lived. It is astonishing to see the prominence and the place prayer had in the life of Christ.

Certain stubborn facts will not go away. Jesus actually taught little about prayer - the greatest teaching is recorded in Luke 11, when the apostles asked Him to teach them how to pray. He warned about the abuses of prayer: First, we can pray like hypocrites (Matthew 6:5), and second, we can pray like the pagans (Matthew 6:7). Jesus was very "low key" concerning prayer. He advised us to have our own personal "prayer closets." Jesus said prayers given privately (in secret) would be rewarded publicly. Jesus rebuked prayers of pride and show.

Jesus never promoted prayer. He warned against "vain repetitions," but He advocated persistence. Peter is the only apostle recorded in the Bible as being prayed for by name by Jesus (Luke 22:31-32). With Jesus, there was never drama, theater, pageantry, novelty, performance, or orchestration. Prayer, to Jesus, was authentic.

The *real fact* is that prayer had priority with Jesus. With most of us, prayer is the preparation for the battle. With Jesus, prayer was the battle itself! In the life of Christ, prayer was the work, while ministry was the prize. Where was it that the sweat dropped like blood? *Not* at the sea of Galilee, *not* at Pilate's hall, and *not* at Golgotha! The "sweat became like drops of blood" when Jesus was in prayer at Gethsemane (Luke 22:44). When the test came, Jesus won, because He had previously handled it with prayer. We fail in life because we fail in prayer!

For Jesus, nothing was more important than being with and talking with the Father. The decision was made at Gethsemane, not Calvary! Truly, He was the "Praying Christ."
