

The Mind of Christ is Faithful in Opposition

It is well known that our culture has been gradually becoming more ungodly over the past several generations. In 1962 the Engel v. Vitale court case removed prayer from schools and the 1973 Roe v. Wade case ruled that it is lawful to kill the unborn. Since that time Christianity has grown to face more cultural opposition with seemingly no end in sight.

The persecution faced by Christians in the first century was far more intense than anything most of us can fathom. Paul and Silas were unlawfully beaten in Philippi, but they went on to preach the gospel and establish a church there (Acts 16). It was to this church that Paul wrote, "Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that

whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel; in no way alarmed by your opponents..." (Phil. 1:27-28, NASB). Even in a culture that was willing to physically attack the church, Paul encouraged them to remain faithful. One of the main keys to this kind of faithfulness can be seen in what Paul wrote and is still just as important today. He wrote that he wanted to hear of them "striving together."

As the world today grows more hostile to the truth, the way for us to remain faithful is to encourage and rely on one another. God calls us to faithfulness, but He does not ask us to remain faithful all by ourselves. In order to be faithful we must be connected to and active in the Lord's church.
