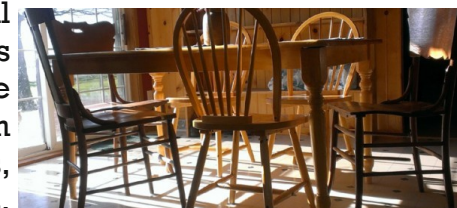

A Christian who has relocated can have two home congregations. The one they currently attend and the one of their youth.

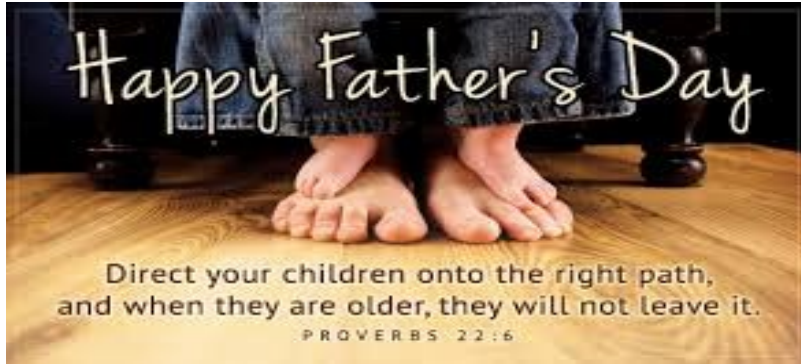
