Moral Courage

Most people have little difficulty taking a stand on politics, social issues, sports, and the like. They will tell you what they think on a particular subject without even having to be asked. Some must even be avoided lest we subject ourselves to an endless harangue on the "issue of the day."

Christianity is not always given the same consideration. We often place "religion" in the realm of opinion, even though we can be dogmatic on a host of other matters. Yet, of the seven Christian graces mentioned by Peter in his second epistle, he begins by teaching us to add to our faith virtue, or moral courage. Its placement immediately after faith, however, would appear to no coincidence.

There are many examples in the Bible of those who placed courage ahead of personal safety or
