### **Our Giving**

As was mentioned in last week's article, thanksgiving is grateful acknowledgement of benefits or blessings received. One of the five acts of worship the New Testament authorizes us to perform on the first day of the week is our offering. Through inspiration, the apostle Paul instructs the Corinthians (and us) "On the first day of the week…lay something aside, storing up as he may prosper…" (I Corinthians 16:2 NKJV).

Our collections have in many places become an after thought or a duty we perform, and not an act of worship to God. We rush through the collection without a thought as to why we are doing what we are doing. We are worshiping Jehovah God by the giving of our means. We are to purpose in our hearts according to how we have prospered (to purpose in the heart means to plan our giving ahead of time – as soon as we "prosper" we should immediately set aside that amount which we will offer to God on the next Lord's day). We should always offer our gifts to Him cheerfully (II Corinthians 9:6-8).

We also should remove "vain repetitions" from our vocabulary during this time which have entrenched themselves in our worship services (Matthew 6:7). We are not "giving back to the church," nor are we "giving to the work of the church." Giving is an act of worship to God. Yes, the monies will be used for the work of the church, but that is the result of our giving, not the reason. Likewise, we should not be encouraged to "give a small portion" of our prosperity, but

rather to be generous in our worship just as God was generous in His giving (John 3:16).

Finally, we should never forget that the Lord see us when we give (Mark 12:41). He sees **who** gives, He sees **what** is given, and He sees **the attitude** with which it is given.

Savior Thy dying love, Thou gavest me.

Nor should I ought withhold, dear Lord from Thee.

In love my soul would bow, my heart fulfill its vow,

Some offering bring Thee now, something for Thee.


