

The Mind of Christ is Humble

In 2001 Toby Keith released a song entitled, "I Wanna Talk about Me." The song highlights a problem that is as old as humanity – selfishness. It is all about someone who only wants to discuss themselves and never anyone else.

This problem can be seen at times throughout scripture and is the source of conflicts within the church. One church that dealt with internal quarreling was Philippi (4:2). Paul wrote to them that they should "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others" (Phil. 2:3-4, NIV). For the church in Philippi to be unified, they needed to put others ahead of themselves – which does not come naturally.

The way Paul tells the church to do this is through looking to Christ. He is the ultimate example of humility in that He put others first to the point of death. The same is true for us today. Unity in the church happens when we have the humility to put others first just as Christ does.

all the children and their parents or grandparents to get together to play and fellowship with one another. Remember to bring a sack lunch. Please see the flyer on the bulletin board for all the details.


Ladies Day Planning Meeting: Sunday, meeting June 26th, there will be a short planning meeting following morning worship services.
