### Dig Deep

"Why do you call me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do what I tell you? Everyone who comes to me and hears my words and does them, I will show you what he is like: he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when a flood arose, the stream broke against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built. But the one who hears and does not do them is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. When the stream broke against it, immediately it fell, and the ruin of that house was great." - Luke 6:46-49

If you know God's word and walk according to it, consistently correcting yourself when you find yourself thinking, feeling or acting wrong, you will be ready for whatever forces come against you. Continuing in this state of readiness means that when challenges to your faith come suddenly and unexpectedly, you will not lose your faith, you will not be without recourse, you will not be confused and

dismayed.


The man whose house withstood the flood expended time and effort to prepare the house. He knew that his house needed a foundation. He **“dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock.”** It takes time to know God’s word. The Bible is not merely a list of commands - it reveals the character and personality of God. It takes effort to know God’s word. Through history, poems, prophecy, and parables, through many pages of writing, and through prayer and teaching, we gain insight.


A superficial reading or selective reading can be worse than none at all, if we make assumptions, filter the Bible through our own culture, or pick and choose texts that are “easy” or which suit our prejudices.


The floodwaters are rising quickly - you have the tools. Get digging!
