Do You Know?

The apostle presents **knowledge** as the second of seven Christian graces we should add to our faith if we are to avoid being "barren and unfruitful" (II Peter 1:5-11). In secular law, ignorance of the law is no defense. Likewise, the Bible is clear that our ignorance of God's will is not, and will never be, a defense (Matthew 25:31-45).

The Hebrew writer rebukes those Christians for their spiritual immaturity, and mentions the dangers of not growing (maturing) as Christians (Hebrews 5:12-6:6). Like them, many of us "have eyes, but do not see, and ears, and do not hear" (Matthew 13:15). The importance of Biblical knowledge can never be over-stated.

"It cannot be denied that there are individuals, families, and even churches in our world, almost, if

not entirely, destitute of a knowledge of the one true God, and especially of the principles and operations of His religion as developed by His Son.” This quote is so pertinent in our day, yet, it was written in July 1855, by Tolbert Fanning in the first edition of the *Gospel Advocate*. The more things change, the more they stay the same!

We know box scores, details of celebrities, automobile statistics, all the songs in the top 40, and other useless trivia. But do we know how to lead a soul to Christ? “...but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ” (II Peter 3:18).

Come, let us learn and grow together.
